



# PARENT PLANNING GUIDE CAMDEN COUNTY COLLEGE

If your child is planning to attend Camden County College in Fall 2021, here is a checklist of important steps that you can help them complete now!

- ✔ **Complete Admissions Application:** If your child has not already applied, have them do so immediately. More information on the application and admissions process can be found [here](#).
- ✔ **Submit the FAFSA:** Submitting the FAFSA requires your input and information, and will impact your child's financial aid options. If you have not already done this, this is your step to do now! Make sure to include CCC on the list of colleges your child is interested in attending.

## After your child is accepted, make sure that they have completed these steps by the end of April...

- ✔ **Take the Placement Test:** Due to COVID-19, CCC is not allowing walk-in testing. The college is only conducting appointment-based, in-person Placement Testing. Your child's performance on this test determines the level of classes they are eligible to register for. To make an appointment, simply complete the online reservation form on the college's website. In preparation for the test, your child can take a practice Accuplacer test to help prepare!
- ✔ **Schedule an Advising Appointment:** Your child should schedule an appointment with Academic Advising to review major course requirements to ensure your child is on track for the upcoming semester. The office is offering both in person and online appointments.
- ✔ **Register for Classes:** In order to register for classes, your child must have completed all the steps listed above. Instructions on how to register for classes can be found online, as well as in their CCC portal.

## Finally, before the end of May...

- ✔ **Review Financial Aid Award & Verification:** All student award letters and billing information can be found in your child's CCC portal. Spend some time with your child reviewing the documents found on the Financial Aid tab. If your child is selected for Financial Aid verification you will need to complete and submit the requested documentation through their CCC portal. In preparation for this, you may want to request your IRS transcripts now. Specific questions about financial aid can be sent to [financialaid@camdenccc.edu](mailto:financialaid@camdenccc.edu)

### Students with Accommodations

After your child has submitted their enrollment paperwork, they will need to request accommodations from the disability services office at CCC.

Talk to your child's case manager about the accommodations he/she has received during high school and how it has helped. Make sure to include your child in that conversation. Then have your child schedule an initial meeting with the disability services office.
