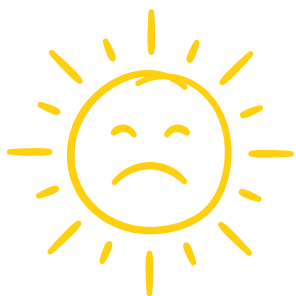
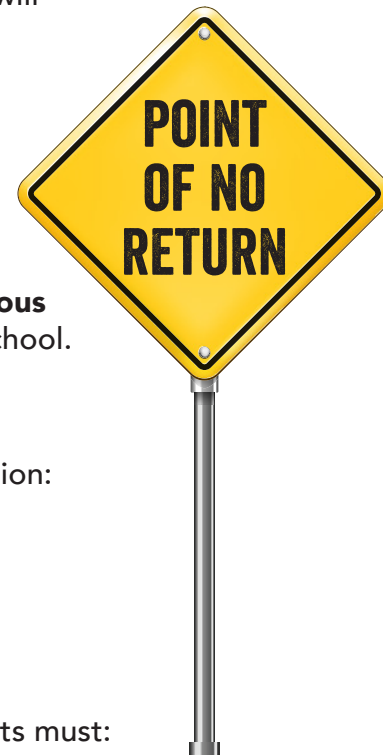


Credit recovery for failed courses

DANGER!

- High school students with **9+ absences** in a course per report period will automatically receive a **failing grade of 50**.
- **While credit recovery is available to students** who fail courses and need to get back on track to earn credit, this should be **CONSIDERED A LAST RESORT FOR STUDENTS**.
- Students will need to **meet rigorous requirements and give up precious summer time** to complete credit recovery coursework at a Mastery school.
- High schools will work with students to determine options to recover credits for courses they previously failed that are required for graduation:
 - **Retake the course in full during the following school year.**
 - **Retake the course via Edmentum over the summer or during an upcoming school year.**
- To successfully complete the summer credit recovery program, students must:
 - **Participate in 90 minutes of learning each day for every failed course.**
 - **Complete the entire course and earn a grade of 65% or higher to pass.**
 - **Have no more than one excused or unexcused absence during the full summer session.**



This is not the old-fashioned version of summer learning many are familiar with, where students simply complete standard assignments to recover credits they missed during the school year.

We've heard from students that credit recovery can feel **MORE CHALLENGING** and **DEMANDING** due to the compressed timeline for learning and the competing priorities that summer often presents.

***Please note:** Students may take a maximum of two Edmentum credit recovery courses each year (from fall semester to summer term) and up to six total Edmentum credit recovery courses throughout their high school experience.
