



GRADUATE READY GUIDE

CAMDEN COUNTY COLLEGE

If your student plans to attend Camden County College (CCC) in the fall, follow this checklist of important actions to help them prepare for their next step.

- ✔ **Complete admissions application:** If your senior has not already applied, have them do so immediately. For more information on the application and admissions process, please visit the CCC's website.
- ✔ **Submit the FAFSA:** Submitting the FAFSA requires your input and will impact your student's financial aid options. If you haven't already done this, this is the next step to take now. Make sure to include CCC on the list of colleges your student is interested in attending.
- ✔ **Take the placement test (if applicable):** CCC offers in-person and virtual placement testing options to students. Your student will need to request an appointment for either in-person or virtual testing using the online testing registration form. Please ensure that your student uses their college email and student ID when completing the form. Your student must take the test seriously. The results will determine the level of classes your student is eligible to register for in the fall semester. In preparation, your student can take a practice ACCUPLACER test.
- ✔ **Complete the student planning online resource:** Your student must complete the virtual student planning before registering for courses. They can find the video resource on CCC's website.
- ✔ **Register for classes:** To register for classes, your senior must have completed all the steps listed above and meet with an academic advisor. - ✔ **Family meeting:** Participate in a family meeting with your student and their Postsecondary Advisor. During this meeting you will review your student's final plan, go over financial aid, and ensure your questions are answered about the enrollment process.
- ✔ **Review financial aid award and verification:** All student award letters and billing information can be found in your senior's CCC portal. Spend some time with your student reviewing the documents found on the Financial Aid tab. If your student is selected for Financial Aid verification, you will need to complete and submit the requested documentation through their CCC portal. In preparation for this, you may want to request your IRS transcripts proactively. For specific questions about financial aid, please email financialaid@camdenccc.edu.

Students with accommodations

After your student has submitted their enrollment paperwork, they will need to request accommodations from the Disability Services Office at CCC.

Discuss with your student's case manager the accommodations they have received during high school and how they have benefited them. Make sure to include your student in that conversation. Then, have your student schedule an initial meeting with the Disability Services Office.
